- Education through Vegetation – The College initiated a new concept Education through vegetation by growing vegetables in the campus using non-degradable materials and bio compost produced in the campus. The produce is sold and proceeds are utilized to pay the fees of poor students.
- A solar power plant was installed to supply electricity to the entire Degree Block, promoting sustainable and eco-friendly energy use on campus.
